

# Surveying Timber & Dampness in Buildings

Please be aware of two changes that have been made in relation to the Surveyor's training course which have come into effect on 1st January 2016.

## Change 1: Course Title

The Association, as part of its continual review of training offerings, felt that the existing title of 'Surveyor in Remedial Treatments' did not accurately reflect the aims and content of the course.

In light of this review, the decision was taken to change the title of this course to "Surveying Timber and Dampness in Buildings".

**Note:** This training course is **still suitable foundation study** for the Certificated Surveyor in Remedial Treatments [CSRT] qualification.

## Change 2: Course Content on Day 3

Following feedback from both delegates and tutors, content of the third and final day of this training has been changed.

Day 3 of this training course will now cover topics including the following:

- Responsibilities and liability
- Survey enquiry analysis
- Survey methodology
- The function and content of a survey report

The Health & Safety training elements that used to be covered in Day 3, are now delivered via the new PCA on-line Health & Safety Training (*details overleaf*).

*All delegates wishing to sit the CSRT exam are strongly advised to complete the separate Health & Safety e-learning prior to sitting the CSRT exam.*

# Health & Safety Training New E-learning Developed

The Association has developed an e-learning package to deliver the Health & Safety (H&S) aspects of the PCA training courses.

**It is strongly recommended that this e-learning is completed by all delegates who are undertaking PCA training courses.**

This is because the e-learning covers important topics that are relevant to professionals working in these areas. Also, for those delegates going on to sit the CSRT and CSSW examinations, these will specifically examine areas covered by the e-learning module.

## How does the e-learning module work?

- ⇒ Delegates are e-mailed an individual link and password.
- ⇒ Delegates have one month from the date they receive their access details to complete the training module.
- ⇒ Complete all in one go, or save progress to continue later on. In total it should take delegates 2—3 hours to complete.
- ⇒ At the end of each section (16 in total) there are 10 multiple choice questions. A mark of 90% is required to move to the next section. Delegates can review a section a retake the test if they do not pass first time.
- ⇒ Once successfully completed, a certificate of completion is issued.

## How much does it cost?

Just £35.00 + vat.

- ◆ **Complete at your own pace:** in one session or in a number of 'visits'
